

Do you need EPA Section 608 Certification to handle refrigerants?

HVAC Sales & Supply Co. Inc. is offering a REVIEW class and test session for Section 608 Certification.

EPA Certification is required for anyone that opens the refrigerant circuit of a piece of equipment. In other words anyone that attaches gauges to an air conditioning or refrigeration unit is required to have this certification.

If you work on air-conditioning units or refrigeration units (that includes window units and household refrigerators) – or if you want to get into the business – you need this certification. That includes service technicians, installers and maintenance personnel.

There are four levels of certification:

Type I – Small appliances

Type II – High pressure systems –

Equipment using high pressure refrigerants such as R22 & R410A.

Including conventional comfort air conditioning systems (residential and commercial) and many supermarket and process refrigeration units.

Type III – Low pressure refrigerants – primarily low pressure chillers (Absorption)

***Due to low demand we will not review this type in class so that the time can be used for the more common high pressure systems. However, candidates can take the Type III test if they choose. Low pressure review can be done in person (review materials are available for purchase), or a low pressure review session can be arranged separately.**

Universal – candidates passing all three types is certified as Universal.

To achieve certification a candidate must pass the core and the “Type” tests up to and including the level at which they wish to be certified. For instance, a technician wishing Type II certification must pass: Core, Type I, and Type II.
